4/22/2020 @7pm VIRTUAL meeting minutes

- Approved March meeting minutes
- 1. B&J is working on our DCED grant for the station Rd/5th Street bridge and trail. We have \$70,112 in escrow for Station Rd. (15% match; Max is \$250,000) This will only get the trail to the Hidden meadow's development. We will work on future grants to extend this to the schoolhouse and other trails in the park.
- 2. Community Garden. Matthew Feehan expressed on FB he would like to run this going forward. We will use 2020 as a build year and then relaunch in 2021. Matt will complete a volunteer form.
- 3. Rail trail construction is moving slow under a PA exemption.
- 4. LVHN wants to sponsor a Water Station/ Bike repair/ bike rack in Veteran's park where trail exits. Want to avoid signs on trail but in the park could be a sponsorship. They can provide up to \$20-25k. We will continue to explore but running water to the site may be too expensive.
 - a. Bike repair station: \$800
 - b. Bike racks: \$650
 - c. Doggy and me water station: \$3,500
- 5. Toll Gate Land HOA. A draft Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was approved by the BOS. A request was sent to the solicitor to review and then submit to the HOA for an approval. If approved by the HOA It will allow AMC to submit a grant for engineering costs and more exact estimates. We will follow up with Link to see where we are with getting that to Milford to review.
- 6. 2020 Activity Schedule and Dates (My recommendation is follow CDC guidelines and closes all events through May 15th) PA will issue updates we will follow for Bucks County.
 - a. Trail Clean Up Day, delayed
 - b. Road Clean Up Day, delayed
 - c. June 12th The Secret Life of Pets 2 (we will wait and see if a go forward)
 - d. July 10th Frozen 2 (wait and see)
 - e. August 14th Toy Story 4, Maybe we move Two moves to August.
 - f. Community Day (9/19/20) is still on at this point.
- 7. Bird town is still under review from Audubon, it is done on our end.
