Trail Update

- Rail Trail - Rail removal started on rail trail, section from California rd to Vet Park (100 yards) may be a work around with rail with trail as land owner impossible to respond to requests.

- PA Highlands Trail - Signs Installed. Signs stolen/removed by BCWS in Brayton Garden. Tom contacted Paul S. about replacement
- Veteran's Park Trail - Extension by AMC (see PDF). AMC is applying for a grant. Supervisors approved matching expenses up to \$7,000 in funds to build the trail.
