

Effective Thursday May 11, 2023, line painting will occur between the Township line at Rich Hill Rd and heading north on Old Bethlehem Pike to the Township line at Quakertown Borough. (vicinity of the skate park)

During the course of this work, please understand:

- Minor traffic delays may occur;
- If you encounter a line painting truck and crew on the road, please be patient and stay well clear of the truck and workers; and
- Wet traffic paint on the road may splatter on your vehicle if crossed before the paint has dried; therefore, drivers are reminded to obey all signage and warning signs to avoid paint damage.

NOTICE OF ROAD WORK

RICHLAND TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS

Starting May 9th 2023 thru May 12th 2023, and May 15th 2023 from the hours of 6:30 AM to 5:30 PM the roads listed below are scheduled to have repaving work completed.

May 9th –

Old Bethlehem Pike –

Starting first we will complete the section from Station Rd to the borough line. At this time, we will limit most thru traffic to this section. Still allowing local residents and bus traffic to get through.

After completing the first section. We will close the round about at Station Rd to quickly and fully complete the round about before reopening. The round about will most likely be closed for a period of time around Noon.

May 10th –

Old Bethlehem Pike –

Starting first with the section between Station Rd and Tollgate Rd. We will once again limit the flow of thru traffic, while still allowing local residents and bus traffic.

After completing the first section. We will then move over to the section between Tollgate Rd and Richhill Rd. This section will be treated the same, allowing local traffic and limiting thru traffic.

May 11th –

Redwood Dr, Misty Lane, and one lane on Sunshine Dr. All local traffic will be permitted.

May 12th –

Cedar Dr, Cypress Dr, and complete lane on Sunshine Dr. All local traffic will be permitted.

May 15th –

Golden Gate Dr, Cable Car Dr, San Francisco Dr, and Sacramento Dr. All local traffic will be permitted.

There will be NO on-street parking during this phase of construction. No Parking signs will be installed in advance of the operations to notify you of the exact days the work will occur. The streets will remain open to local traffic, however please be extra careful of personnel working around the paving operation.

Flaggers will be positioned at all intersections to help maintain local access to all roads while under construction. Road Closed signs will be set to deter heavy thru traffic during construction.
