

Richland Trails Update

It's been a busy year for the trails committee and the road crew. To date we have five sections of the trails under construction and well on their way to completion. The trails currently under construction are in Walnut Bank Farms, Hunters Crossing, Regency Manor, Brayton Gardens and Beaver Run.

- The Walnut Bank Farm Trail is located in Walnut Bank Farms and will connect to the Borough. This trail will be a great asset to those residents who live in and around Walnut Bank Farms as they will be able to bike or hike to the new library and the new pool. This trail is currently completed and should be dedicated by the end of this year.

- The Brayton Gardens Trail, which will be 9,966 linear feet long, is about 75% constructed. This trail is being built by the developer and it will connect with Franklin Lane. Estimated completion will be in 2005.

- The Regency Manor Trail has been installed. With a length of 1,702 linear feet, this trail is anticipated to be dedicated in 2006.

- The Hunters Crossing Trail is 25% complete. The trail's length will total 3,370 linear feet when completed and will connect to Park Avenue in Quakertown.

- The Beaver Run trail is about 40% complete. This trail will be 1,902 linear feet when completed.
