Agenda

- Brayton Gardens Park
 - The committee asked Tim if there were any updates on the park. The Committee was informed that everything is on schedule.
 - Cindy asked if anyone had any other ideas for a park name besides: Barrel Run Park, Great Blue Heron Park or something with Unami in the name. It was suggested again that we not tie it in with Brayton Gardens neighborhood name
 - 5K run - will be after the park completion or the following Spring – The committee spoke about traffic control – and it was mentioned to see if we could get help from Fire Police so the police do not incur overtime.
