CRIMES:

On May 15, 2017, Richland Township PD was dispatched to Dollar Tree, 50 N. West End Blvd., for the report of a retail theft. An unidentified woman stole approximately \$15-\$20 worth of merchandise and fled the area.

ARRESTS:

On May 9, 2017, Richland Twp. PD filed charges against Elizabeth Blaker-Sampson, 27, of East Greenville, for retail theft and receiving stolen property from Target on April 19th, when she stole \$257 worth of baby formula from the store.

On May 9, 2017, Richland Township Police Dept. filed charges against Mark Heiserman, 61, of Emmaus, PA, for leaving the scene of an accident at Wawa, 600 N. West End Blvd. on May 4th. The accident involved personal injury. He was also cited for driving under suspension and failing to render aid or give information.

On May 15, 2017, RTPD filed felony charges against Jesse Ryan Gerhard, 21, of Green Top Road, West Rockhill Township, for being a fugitive from justice. While investigating a retail theft, police received information of an outstanding warrant against Gerhard from Allegany County, Maryland.

On May 18, 2017, Richland Township PD filed charges against Brandon Grosso, 32, of Washington Court, Hilltown Township, for aggravated assault, possession of an instrument of crime and recklessly endangering another person following police investigation into an incident at Walmart where a shotgun was fired at a vehicle. With the help of surrounding police departments, Grosso was apprehended, arraigned and sent to Bucks County Prison.
