CRIMES:

Richland Township Police Dept. has responded to several theft from vehicle calls this past week occurring in the Sweetbriar Development, just off of Trumbauersville Road. The vehicles, locked and unlocked, had items removed from them. Police urge that residents keep their vehicles locked, take all valuables out of vehicles and leave any exterior lights on in an attempt to deter this type of crime.

ARRESTS:

On September 11, 2017, Richland Twp. PD filed felony retail theft charges against Kimberly Anderson-Smoot, 29, of Jenkintown, PA, after investigating a theft of food items at Wawa, 1095 S. West End Blvd., Quakertown. She placed the items in her purse, exited the store and left the area in a vehicle.

On September 12, 2017, RTPD filed felony theft charges, as well as a misdemeanor charge of unauthorized use of motor vehicle, against Timothy Krokowski, 40, of Myrtle Beach, SC, after investigating a report of a missing vehicle. The vehicle was later found in New York City by the victim.

On September 19, 2017, Richland Twp. Police Dept. filed theft charges against Jennifer Sherry, 39, of Newbury Court, Sellersville, for taking items off the shelves at Walmart and returning them to customer service for a cash refund in the amount of \$51.
